Make a birthday card **Pentecost is the church's birthday**

You will need: piece of paper or card, envelope, felt pens

1. Choose somebody to make a birthday card for
2. Fold the paper or card in half
2. Design and make the front of the card
3. Write 'Happy Birthday' on the card and write the inside.
4. Put it in the envelope and write the person's name on



Make some bunting for a party **We celebrate the birthday of the church at Pentecost**

You will need: pieces of paper, scissors, string, felt pens, sellotape or stapler

1. Cut as many triangles out of the paper as you can
2. Decorate each triangle
3. Attach them to the string and hang your bunting in your bedroom



Make a Pentecost biscuit **The church began at Pentecost**

You will need: digestive biscuit, icing sugar, bowl, red and yellow icing or cake decorations, knife

1. Make up some thick icing in a bowl
2. Spread it on the biscuit and add the coloured icing or decorations



Wind chime **The Holy Spirit came like a wind**

You will need: a plastic cup, felt pens, string or wool, beads

1. Use the felt pens to decorate the cup
2. Ask an adult to put a hole in the top of the cup and lots of holes round the bottom of it
3. Thread the beads on pieces of wool or string and thread them through the bottom of the cup
4. Put a piece of string or wool through the top



Hairdryer game **The wind was roaring**


You will need: hairdryer, ping pong ball or scrunched up piece of paper

1. See who can keep the ball in the air longest with the hairdryer



Make a windmill **The wind came from heaven**

You will need: a square piece of paper, ruler, pencil, Scissors, felt pens, straw, split pin or stapler, pens, scissors, pencil, felt pens, paper, sellotape

1. Use the ruler and pencil to draw lines on the paper square like this 
2. Cut along the lines and fold the paper as shown.
3. Colour the windmill
4. Fold the sections of the windmill in
5. Attach the windmill to the straw



Make a kite to fly **The Holy Spirit came like a strong wind**

You will need: a piece of card, string, felt pens, scissors magazine pages or tissue paper, pencil, hole punch

1. Draw a kite shape on the card and cut it out
2. Draw flames on the kite
3. Put a hole in the bottom of your kite and tie the string through the hole
4. Cut rectangles out of the magazine. Scrunch them up and tie them to string
5. Tie a piece of string to the kite. Take it outside and fly it.



Make a flame painting **The Holy Spirit came like a flame**

You will need: paper, red and yellow paint, straw

1. Drop red and yellow paint on the paper
2. Blow it into a flame shape by using the straw



Make a flame head dress **The Holy Spirit settled on the disciples' heads like a flame**

You will need: a rectangular strip of card, paper, scissors, stapler or selloptape, felt pens

1. Make a band that fits round your head to make a band
2. Decorate the head dress with flames



Arm wrestle **The Holy Spirit made Peter strong**

You will need: a table, people in you house

1. Have an arm wrestle, who is the strongest?

Make a dove **Peter spoke in new languages**

You will need: a piece of paper, felt pens, pencil

1. Draw a dove on your paper
2. Use different coloured pens to write 'peace' in different languages: pace, shalom, paix, spokoj, peace, vrede



Make a flag **People from all over the world heard Peter speaking in their language**

You will need: rectangular piece of paper, straw, felt pens

1. Draw a flag on your paper, this could be the flag from your country
2. Colour it in. On the back write a prayer to God for the people there.



Make a dove string **The dove is a symbol of the Holy Spirit**

You will need: paper, scissors, string, sellotape, dove template (see below).

1. Print out the doves or draw some on the paper
2. Cut them out and attach them to the string. Hang up.




Make praying hands **Peter told people about Jesus**

You will need: paper, scissors, felt tips

1. Fold the paper in half.
2. Put your hand on the crease and draw round it.
3. Cut round your hand but not down the crease.
4. Open the hands and write the names of people you would like to tell about Jesus.




Dove Template







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Pentecost Maze


